As Europe accelerates its transition toward a hydrogen-based economy, Hy2Market partners continue to demonstrate how regional collaboration drives real progress. In Sicily, five project partners are advancing a 1 MW green hydrogen pilot that integrates hydrogen into power generation, a major step for industrial decarbonisation in Southern Europe. At the EU level, Hy2Market was showcased during the I3 Support Facility Virtual Event organised by EISMEA, where Project Manager Dirk Koppert shared lessons on effective interregional project management. Meanwhile, in the Northern Netherlands, partner HyEnergy Consultancy Limited has published a new study exploring the potential of liquid hydrogen for transport and industry, positioning the region as a future hub for clean hydrogen logistics. Together, these initiatives underline Hy2Market's mission to turn regional innovation into practical pathways for Europe's hydrogen market deployment. Hy2Market Regional Highlight: Sicily, Italy

In Sicily, five Hy2Market partners, CNR-ITAE, Duferco, De Nora, SNAM, and Power Evolution, are advancing a pioneering 1 MW green hydrogen pilot at the Giammoro site. The electrolyser, supplied by De Nora, will produce hydrogen for blending into Duferco's 58 MW turbine, reducing CO₂ emissions and supporting grid regulation. CNR-ITAE provides scientific expertise, Power Evolution leads optimisation and scale-up, and SNAM explores how existing infrastructure can integrate hydrogen into hard-to-abate sectors. Together, these efforts position Sicily as a key testing ground for hydrogen integration in Southern Europe.

Developed by Hy2Market partner HyEnergy Consultancy Limited, this new study explores the potential of liquid hydrogen (LH₂) in the Northern Netherlands, analysing its benefits for industrial, maritime, and aviation applications. With a focus on the Delfzijl–Eemshaven area, the report highlights how the region's strong hydrogen infrastructure and offshore wind capacity could make it a leading hub for clean liquid hydrogen in northwestern Europe.
