Hy2Market Regional Highlight: Constanța, Romania

In Constanţa, Romania, Hy2Market partners MEDGreen Cluster and IAC Special Projects are advancing hydrogen production and zero-emission mobility solutions tailored to regional needs. MEDGreen is developing a modular waste-to-hydrogen unit that converts waste biomass into hydrogen and biochar, alongside work on hydrogen separation from syngas. In parallel, IAC Special Projects is leading the feasibility and technical development of a hydrogen fuel cell minibus for public transport applications. Their combined efforts embody Hy2Market's mission of supporting local hydrogen ecosystems while contributing to Europe's wider decarbonisation objectives.

Deliverable 6.3: Final Training Guidelines

The latest Hy2Market report was developed collaboratively by CluBE – Cluster of Bioeconomy and Environment of Western Macedonia, New

Energy Coalition, Business Upper Austria, and WIVA P&G, with input from partners across the consortium. The report maps existing hydrogen education and training in Europe and compares it with market needs identified through desk research and a survey of 38 Hy2Market partners. It highlights the central role of on-the-job learning, peer knowledge exchange, and external training, while identifying gaps between formal education and the practical skills required across hydrogen production, transport, and enduse.
